

## NATIONAL RECOGNITION

High Point University president Dr. Nido Qubein's inspiring life story is one filled with adversity and abundance. It is through the lens of his life accomplishments that one appreciates his current role as an educator, philanthropist and passionate advocate for the development of our future leaders.

Not many university presidents teach a class, but Dr. Nido Qubein always proves the exception to the rule and, in fact, teaches two classes. At the age of 17, he came to the U.S. with little money and limited command of the English language. His achievements have earned him the Ellis Island Medal of Honor, induction into the Horatio Alger Society of Distinguished Americans and placement within the National Speaker's Association Hall of Fame. Dr. Qubein is a nationally recognized speaker, author and consultant.

- Become impactful citizens






















#### **CLIMATE**



#### NATIVE SPEAKERS OF ENGLISH

Students applying from countries where the native language is English must submit an SAT or ACT score in lieu of a TOEFL or IELTS score. Students attending a high school where they are instructed primarily in English may also submit an SAT or ACT score.

## **ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE**

Unlike many universities, HPU offers both Intensive English Instruction as well as Advanced English as a Second Language courses. All non-native English speakers applying to the university must submit a TOEFL or an IELTS score. Students who are academically qualified but do not meet TOEFL or IELTS requirements may be admitted to HPU on the condition that they attend our partner language school, the American Language Academy in Greensboro, North Carolina prior to enrolling.

All students, regardless of the results of their English proficiency exams, will take an English placement exam on campus that will determine whether they will need to enroll in our English as a Second Language courses on campus. These are academic, credit-bearing courses that count as the student's foreign language requirement. All students have access to support services such as ESL tutoring free of charge.

#### **HEALTH SERVICES**

High Point University's goal is to become our students' home away from home. As such, all international students must enroll in High Point University's medical insurance. HPU is one of only three private universities in North Carolina to have a full-time medical doctor as director of the student health center. This means that all students have access to quality care whenever they need it.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

The High Point University Transportation Department offers the following complimentary services to students:

- CAMPUS SHUTTLES: continual shuttle service for locations on campus.
- SHOPPING SHUTTLES: service to Wal-Mart, Target, local grocery stores and shopping centers.
- MEDICAL, DENTAL AND SPECIAL NEEDS: transportation for doctor, dentist and physical therapy appointments.
- AIRPORT AND HIGH POINT TRAIN STATION SHUTTLES: service to/ from the High Point Amtrak Train Station, Piedmont-Triad International Airport, Raleigh-Durham International Airport and Charlotte Douglas International Airport.

### MAKING HPU HOME

High Point University is by design a residential campus. Ninety-nine percent of all first year students and 93 percent of all students live on campus. All HPU students live on campus until they reach senior status. This promotes a rich and engaging campus life and also allows international students to hone their English language skills while truly experiencing what living on a college campus has to offer. Roommate selection is based on results from a housing survey about individual living preferences. This is especially important for international students, as your roommate will likely be the person you practice your English with the most.









#### **DINING**

With 13 dining venues located throughout campus, students have a variety of menu options to suit their palates. We recognize that many students have specific dietary needs, and we gladly offer many accommodations including special dietary and nutritional programs.
