

TEACHER RESIDENCY LICENSURE PROGRAM



As one of several pathways to teacher licensure, the North Carolina Department of Education offers a Residency License. Much like a medical residency, this license allows a bachelor's degree completer to serve as a paid teacher, with benefits, while completing a post-baccalaureate licensure program at a university. Upon admission, High Point University will provide a letter that can be shared with your employer as proof of affiliation with a university Educator Preparation Program (EPP). PROGRAM QUALIFICATIONS

1

Be employed (or seeking employment) with a NC school district who will request a residency license from the NC Department of Public Instruction on your behalf

2

Hold a bachelor's degree with a GPA of 2.7 or higher (or are a senior and will hold a bachelor's degree before teaching)

3

Have 24 hours of content coursework in your licensure area OR pass the required content area Praxis exam.

PROGRAMS OF STUDY

Both the Adapted Curriculum and Middle/High/Special Subjects Curriculum are programs of study designed to be completed within one year. All programs start in the summer and conclude at the end of the spring semester.

TUITION

The estimated program cost for the 2021-2022 academic year is \$283 per credit hour or \$5,943, for the entire licensure program. Candidates are billed each semester for course credits. Candidates should plan for incremental tuition increases each academic year.
