

Instructions for Clinician CPI Training

To provide important information regarding use of WebCPI as a tool for assessing student physical therapist performance, and to improve the reliability of the tool, all CI's must complete the APTA CPI training prior to having access to WebCPI. The student training is different, so completing the training as a student will not be sufficient to gain access. The training is of no cost, does not require you to be an APTA member, and takes less than 2 hours. You will receive 0.2 CEUs.

1. Access the PT CPI Training.




3. Review PDF found at the link in #2.

You will be directed to the APTA Learning Center where you can complete the assessment.



- 12. Within one business day your CPI account will be created and linked with your student. Importantly, if you do not have access to the email that you used to sign-in to the APTA you will need to contact CPI (857-304-2045 ptcpiwebsupport@liaisonedu.com) to verbally change your email (we are not allowed to do this). Alternatively, if you have access to the email, but it is not your preferred account, once you log-on to the WebCPI platform you can change your email address, employer, contact information, etc.
