


PREPARE Residency Program—A Partnership Between
High Point University, NC A&T State University, Guilford County Schools,
& the College Preparatory and Leadership Academy (CPLA)

## **Program Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. Completed degree (BA/BS or higher) with a GPA of 2.75 or higher
- 2. Commit to teaching Elementary Education (K-6), Special Education: General Curriculum (K-12) or High School Mathematics (9-12) in Guilford County Schools upon completion.
- 3. Commit to obtaining a North Carolina teaching license.
- 4. Passionate about ensuring all children can learn

If you meet all of these requirements, you are eligible to be considered for PREPARE. As a part of the program, we *PREPARE* you to teach while you continue in your current teacher assistant or residency licensure role. We work in partnership with GCS to ensure you have the training and support you need — and you do not pay any tuition! Tuition costs are covered by the Program through monthly stipends!



- 1. Eighteen-month teaching program that leads to full NC licensure as a teacher. Because this is a partnership with Guilford County Schools, you are able to maintain your full—time employment as a teacher assistant or residency licensed teacher during the program.
- 2. Participants will be expected to teach in Guilford County Schools for a minimum of three years in a high need classroom following program completion.
