

HPU GROWTH MINDSET/RESILIENCE PEDAGOGY GRANTS Fall 2019 call for applications

The High Point University Growth Mindset/Resilience Pedagogy Grants support the creation and application of growth mindset or grit-centered learning opportunities, experiences and/or curricula. In particular, these competitive, \$1,500 grants are awarded to projects that:

- Support the creation of original growth mindset or grit interventions in a collegiate environment,
- Experiment with techniques, strategies, activities, and/or assignments that cultivate a growth mindset or grit-centered culture, and
- Can be presented to the university faculty and staff as a new and innovative growth mindset or grit strategies.

To apply for this professional development opportunity, please submit the following in an email message to Jim Y. Trammell at qep@highpoint.edu:

- A two-to-three page letter of interest detailing:
 - A description of a teaching or learning challenge or problem you propose to address, and a hypothesis of how growth mindset or grit interventions can address the challenge or problem
 - A timeline with semester-by-semester goals for the project.
- A brief CV, approximately 2-3 pages, highlighting your teaching experiences.
- If the project supplements a project or class that is currently offered, also include a syllabus, lesson plan, or other detailed information on the current class, project or opportunity.
