### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Registration for HPU Summer Online, Summer Session I and II will begin at your fall registration date/time.

- Students may register for up to 16 credit hours during the summer; however, students may only register for 12 credit hours for the HPU Summer Online session.
- HPU Students may repeat courses in either Session I, Session II or during HPU Summer Online to improve their GPA. Only courses graded with a C- or below may be repeated. *Courses may not be repeated away from HPU*.
- Course offerings with fewer than 4 students are subject to cancellation due to low enrollment. If you have any questions, please contact the professor of the course before you make plans to attend.

### **VISITING STUDENTS**

Visiting students [non-HPU students] must complete a *Summer School Application* and email the application to Michelle Kirk, <a href="mkirk@highpoint.edu">mkirk@highpoint.edu</a>. ### IMPORTANT HPU SUMMER ONLINE COURSE INFORMATION

**HPU Summer Online** allows you to take an HPU course in the convenience of your own home. The following basic guidelines apply to taking a course through HPU Summer Online.

- Any current HPU student in GOOD academic standing may take an HPU online course. GOOD academic standing is defined as a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 or better when the course begins. Students with less than a 2.40 GPA are expected to discuss the challenges of online courses with their advisor.
- Tips for being a successful online student:
  - o must have good computer skills with ready, reliable access to a computer that has a reasonably fast internet connection, virus protection, headphones and/or speakers, and a browser capable of playing several common multimedia formats.
  - must be able to conduct internet searches and perform other relevant online activities such as setting bookmarks, downloading files, installing software, and changing configurations. (Students who have any technical difficulties related to their online course(s) should contact the High Point University IT Helpdesk online (<a href="http://helpdesk.highpoint.edu">http://helpdesk.highpoint.edu</a>), via e-mail (<a href="http://helpdesk.highpoint.edu">helpdesk.highpoint.edu</a>), or via phone (336-841-HELP(4357)).
  - must be a self-motivated, organized, and independent learner, be able to set and achieve course goals, and be committed to spending a total of 10-20 hours each week on his/her online course(s) (both on the computer and doing assignments, readings, etc.).

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

<u>Financial Assistance</u>: Financial assistance for summer school is limited to federal funds (Pell Grant; Direct Student Loans; Parent PLUS Loan) not used during the 2020-21 academic year or borrowing private loans. You may obtain a Summer Financial Aid Application Form from the Office of Student Financial Planning by calling (336) 841-9124 or by email at finplan@highpoint.edu.

Housing: Single \$2,874 per session and double \$1,959 per session. Rooms will be made available to all students who are enrolled during one or more summer sessions at High Point University. Any student requesting special housing accommodations must complete and submit an ADA Special Housing Needs Request form to the Office of Accessibility Resources and Services. If a student is planning on living on campus during the summer, they need to sign up via the housing portal, <a href="www.highpoint.edu/myhome">www.highpoint.edu/myhome</a>. Once they have logged into the portal, they need to fill out the Summer Application. The University provides beds, dressers, desk and chairs, and free laundry facilities. Please contact the Office of Student Life at (336) 841-9231 or <a href="studentlife@highpoint.edu">studentlife@highpoint.edu</a> with any questions.

<u>Check-In Information</u>: Housing for summer session will be open for check-in from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon. Summer Session I check-in is <u>Sunday</u>, <u>June 6</u>. Summer Session II check-in is on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>July 4</u>. At the start of each summer session, each student will need to take inventory on the condition of their assigned room and report any issues to the Resident Director. When checking out, the Office of Student Life will check the current condition of the room. The student will be assessed for any damage to the room or its contents. Checkout for summer school ends at 5:00 p.m. on the last day of each summer session.

Residential costs include room and board. All residential students enrolled in summer courses automatically include a full meal plan during the summer months.

### **TUITION AND FEES**

- 1. Per credit hour charge for HPU SUMMER ONLINE, Summer Sessions I and II will be \$841 [4 credit course = \$3364]
- 2. Technology fee will be \$198 [Per Session]
- 3. On-campus Housing: Room & Board charge will be \$2874/single or \$1959/double [roommate must be designated] per session.
- 4. Activity fee charge will be \$117 per session [not charged to students doing HPU SUMMER online only].

Any previous balances due <u>must be paid before</u> you can register and pay for summer school. Check the Student Account Center by logging in to your account through my.highpoint.edu for balance information or to make payments.
