2019 Dates

Interest Meeting- March 21st, after UCAB in Phillips 120.

Applications due- March 26th by 5 p.m.

Mandatory campaign meeting- March 27th, 5 - 7 p.m. in Phillips 216

Campaigning starts- March 27th after mandatory meeting.

Campaigning ends- March 31st at 11:59 p.m.

Voting begins - April 1st 12:01 a.m.

Voting ends- April 3rd at 11:59 p.m.

Candidates will be notified of results by April 4th at noon.

Campaigning

- Campaigning can begin after the meeting on Wednesday, March 27th
- Campaigning must end on Sunday, March 31st.
 - No new material may be added after the campaign period has ended.
 - The exception to this rule is any graphic given directly to you by SGA
- Failure to abide by any of these rules will result in automatic removal from the election at the discretion of the President.
- The President has final authority over the entire election process.

Do

Get all materials approved by the President and Publicity Chair.

Hang all campaign materials on information boards in residence halls with painters tape.

Knock on doors and encourage residents to get out and vote.

Encourage fellow students to vote for you, in a respectful manner, on social media during the campaigning period.

Knock and hand out materials.

Allow the SGA Instagram account to follow you.

Follow the SGA Instagram account.

Get all social media campaign material approved by the President and Publicity Chair.

Demonstrate civility through your campaign material.

Post any graphic given to you by SGA to social media during the voting period.

Do Not

Hang up any fliers/posters anywhere without permission

Place any campaign materials in academic buildings or student centers including Wanek or Slane.

Post for "Vote for me, John Doe," after the campaign period has ended.

Slander other candidates.

Slide anything under doors.

Cause any damage to any High Point University property.

Send out any sort of mass e-mail.

Use any sort of banners.

Post new material after campaigning has ended.

Situations of Violation

- Everyone serves as the eyes/ears for the President
- If you see a violation, you have 24 hours to report it.
 - A violation would be going against any of the rules stated previously.
- Report violations to the President
 - Include a detailed description, photos and videos- if applicable.
 - This information is important because the President must file a report.
- You are not snitching- you are ensuring a fair and even race.
