# Transfer Enrollment Checklist

Congratulations on being accepted to High Point University! Now that you're in, what's next? Here is a handy checklist to help you navigate the living and learning path as a new student at HPU:

### PAY YOUR DEPOSIT (DO THIS FIRST!)

You'll be prompted to accept our offer of admission when you log in to your MyHPU page. Pay your deposit here.

### ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNTS

Your HPU email address and log-in information will be sent to your current home email address after you have confirmed your admission by paying your deposit. **HPU EMAIL AND PASSWORD:** 24 hours after your deposit is paid, you will receive your HPU email account and password. **Plan to check this account often.** You will receive important messages about financial aid, tuition, placement testing, course proposals and more!

### APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID

Apply for financial aid by filing your FAFSA. December 1 is our priority aid deadline, however, we award aid until the beginning of the semester. If you plan to apply for financial aid, do it as early as possible for the best packaging. ### HOUSING

Get familiar with our housing options and review the housing

application process through Student Life at 336.841.9231 or at [www.highpoint.edu/residencelife](http://www.highpoint.edu/residencelife). They will reach out to you via email to help you select your housing for the spring.

### REGISTER FOR ORIENTATION

New Student Orientation is held on Sunday, January 13th. You will take care of important business like getting your Passport (HPU student ID) and attending important sessions that will help you get familiar with the campus. You will also be assigned a Peer Mentor who is available to help you during this transition. On January 14 at 11 AM you will attend an Academic Orientation and Registration session in Norton Hall, Room 101. This orientation program is required for all our incoming students. Register on your MyHPU page under Events/Interviews.

### COMPLETE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Before attending orientation, you must complete the required health forms before classes begin on January 15 (including immunization verification and medical history). Find Immunization Forms here: <http://www.highpoint.edu/studenthealth/medical-forms/>.

## Final Steps

### SEND FINAL GRADES

Send your official final college or high school transcripts to the Office of Admissions as soon as your semester is complete. We will also need AP or IB scores and dual enrollment or early college transcripts in order to award appropriate credits.

### SUBMIT PROOF OF INSURANCE

You must submit proof of creditable health insurance. You may opt to purchase a student health insurance plan or submit proof of insurance at [www.highpoint.edu/studentaccounts/student-insurance](http://www.highpoint.edu/studentaccounts/student-insurance).

### PAY YOUR TUITION

**Students are billed electronically and by mail** each semester for tuition, fees, room and board (if applicable). Billing schedules and payment deadlines are available via the Office of Student Accounts at 336.841.9259 or at <https://highpoint.afford.com>.
